Dear Mr. Turner:

The City of Atlanta was one of the first municipalities to use your polypropylene manhole extensions for manhole adjustments. This was done in conjunction with the Georgia Department of Transportation on a state highway within the Atlanta City limits in 1977.

After eight (8) years of monitoring these installed rings and observing no wear or deterioration, we instituted an extensive usage of the rings and have now installed over 10,000 since 1982. They have been used on various types of roadways from residential to arterial and we have been very pleased with the results.

We feel the main benefits of using Turner Company's rings are the ease of installation and the substantial cost savings. We can now adjust a manhole in less than one minute and save over \$400.00 on each adjusted manhole. The City of Atlanta has experienced no failures with your rings and plans to continue using them exclusively in the future.
